

## Showcase South Australia COVID Safe Plan

As the COVID-19 situation continues to evolve, Showcase South Australia is committed to supporting our people, our members and our wider community.

Showcase SA is committed to making informed, balanced and respectful decisions based on the expert medical advice of the Australian authorities. Our response measures are aligned with the advice provided by the Australian Government, Department of Health and Government of South Australia. Showcase SA will continue to actively monitor, review and manage our response to the evolving situation. Ongoing reviews include managing the current and potential impacts on our people, our members and events.

## Measures to prevent and manage the spread of the Coronavirus

- To date, we have implemented key controls to protect the health, safety and wellbeing of our people, our members and our wider community
- Our controls are aligned with the advice provided by the Australian Government, Department of Health and Government of South Australia
- We are taking a precautionary approach that is reasonable, informed and balanced and conducting ongoing reviews to determine if additional controls are required
- Our people are required to work from home for 14 days and seek medical clearance before they return to the office if they:
  - o Had contact with someone who has or is suspected of having COVID-19
  - Have symptoms of COVID-19 (cough, high temperature, shortness of breath)
  - Been living in a house hold with a confirmed case you are to self-quarantine for 14 days after the symptoms cease
- Our people are not to come into the office if they have any flu-like symptoms or are feeling unwell
- Our event guests are not to attend an event if they have any flu-like symptoms or are feeling unwell
- We have restricted our events to a maximum of 300 people at a venue and any separate room or area to a maximum of 75 people (subject to the 1 person per 4 square metre rule)
- We have implemented physical distancing measures aiming to keep 1.5 metres away from other event guests at all times
- All members of the public attending a Showcase SA event are required to complete a health questionnaire prior to attending a Showcase SA event to comply with contact tracing requirements
- All members of the public attending a Showcase SA event are seated at all times during the event
- Food and beverages are to be consumed by patrons while seated at tables that are physically separate from any bar or other area that is used for taking orders
- Our people and event guests must practise good hygiene at all times to prevent the virus spreading
- Showcase SA will only conduct an event at a premise that has completed a COVID Safe Plan
